She is recognized internationally as an expert in mycology and bacteriology and chairs the Mycology Scientific Committee at the Institute of Quality Management in Healthcare. She is also a volunteer with several groups within the Clinical Laboratory Standards Institute and serves on editorial boards for Medical Mycology and the Journal of Clinical Microbiology. Julianne is also an Assistant Professor, Laboratory Medicine and Pathobiology at the University of Toronto.
